
## Matanot Aniyim - Gifts for the Poor: Pe'ah

Farmer Michael wants to do the *mitzvah* of *pe'ah* and leave a corner of his field for the poor. To help him remember which part not to harvest, leave the *pe'ah* (corner) white and color the rest brown.



\* **Pe'ah**: When a farmer harvests his field, he leaves a bit of produce on the corner of his field for the poor. The Torah doesn't say how much to leave, but the rabbis say at least 1/60.
